Welcome to the city of Szczecin



Szczecin - the Paris of North

The vibrant capital of the Zachodniopomorskie, or West Pomeranian province, is a large port city with a fascinating history. Built where the River Oder flows into the Szczecin Lagoon, it offers a captivating combination of old and new for visitors to discover...

The city's three main squares, connected via a radial pattern of streets, are modelled after those in the beloved French capital. Their layout reflects the position of the pyramids of Giza in relation to the Nile and the Orion constellation in relation to the Milky Way. And that's just the start of the city's many attractions...

Many visitors fairly assume that Szczecin lies on the sea – a reasonable expectation for the capital of a province that boasts an incredible 185 kilometres of coastline – but no, it does not. It does, however, lie on the River Oder, a river whose beauty in all fairness can only be described as majestic. Stand on the terraces of the Chrobry Embankment to appreciate it for yourself, or even better set off on a cruise, perhaps visiting the wreck of a 90-metre reinforced concrete German tanker on your way.

The romantics among you should head to the Szczecin Venice, which you can reach either by water, using the services of the Municipal Kayak Tours or simply on foot, crossing a little bridge from Kolumba Street onto Jaskółcza Island. Reflected in the Oder, the characterful brick façades of tenements and 19th-Century buildings of the former distillery and yeast factory bear more than a passing resemblance to the iconic Italian city.

After so much sightseeing, it's time to treat your taste buds. Be sure to try the local speciality – pasztecik (a type of deep-fried pasty or pie) at the cult-status Pasztecik bar in Wojska Polskiego Street, the oldest place selling these delicious treats. You can't miss its huge red letters!



Ibis Szczecin Centrum is located within a 5-minute walk from Szczecin Glowny, the city's main railway and bus station. It offers an underground parking as well as free WiFi throughout. Each spacious room in Ibis Szczecin is air-conditioned and has a private bathroom featuring a shower and a hairdryer. All rooms are fitted with a work desk, a TV and a comfortable bed. Charlie's Corner Restaurant specializes in international and Polish dishes. Guests can relax in an outside seating area. Every morning a buffet breakfast is served. Ibis Szczecin Centrum is located only a 10 minute walk away from Szczecin's Old Town and its cultural center, Pomeranian Dukes' Castle. Public transport facilities are within a 5-minute walk away.

The "Wild Card" is a tournament entry awarded to an individual that fails to qualify in the normal way (but considered having a high ranking or winning a qualifying stage). One per nation will be given and chosen freely by the leader of each nation.

The organizing committee wishes to have your Nation's confirmation of participation, once you have received the Championship Details.

100,00 € /Referee Course and examination (WGKF license) 35,00 € / Referee Briefing

35,00 € / Coach Course (WGKF license)

25,00 € / PAX – Sayonara Party (Includes meal, drinks without alcool)

All participants must have a current certificate of insurance with maximum coverage. This insurance must also be valid in Poland.

The Team Officer must sign a statement that EACH MEMBER OF HIS DELEGATION HAS SPECIAL AND REGULAR INSURANCE, VALID FOR THE YEAR ENDING 2024, AND VALID FOR ANY INCIDENT OCCURRED DURING THE COMPETITION. WE DISCLAIM ALL FORM OF LIABILITY OF THE ORGANIZING COMMITTEE AND WGKF IN THE EVENT OF A POSSIBLE ACCIDENT.

Without these written statements, no one will be allowed to participate in the competition and no money will be refunded.
